
#### + The Candle Of Hope





Like Zacchaeus, the tax collector in our Gospel reading today, the founders of this congregation were despised by the religiously "correct" or "right" in the years following WWII through the early 80s when HIV/AIDS was showing itself in Central NY. Zacchaeus climbed a tree to see and be seen, to hear and be heard by Jesus. Likewise, the people who started Ray Of Hope in Syracuse certainly had to find the inconvenient stoop and platform and use every available means of being heard by and hearing those people who needed us. This has been our journey these entire forty years.

<sup>17</sup> For you say, 'I am rich, I have prospered, and I need nothing.' You do not realize that you are wretched, pitiable, poor, blind, and naked.

Over the years, we have faced the confidence of enormous church institutions, preachers on television, radio, and the Internet. We have faced off with "Christian" academics, "Christian" politicians, theologians, authors, speakers, and even musicians, all telling us they are confident they are right and we are wrong. They have felt rich and powerful in their positions of opposition to us, claiming to have "thousands of years" of "Christian and Jewish Tradition," enriching their energy to blast their message over top of us.

At the same time, during these forty years, there has been a massive volume of Theology, Psychology, Anthropology, and Archeology (and there are more categories) that has shown we are normal; we have been here in every period of human written record and every known

Though we remain small, like a crack in a wall where a little beam of light breaks through, we have found great comfort in the production of academic papers, new films, documentaries, fiction writing, and publications of all kinds that assure us we are who we thought we were all along, regular people, created, loved and sustained by our beloved Creator, and Christ, and Holy Spirit.

I often say; The religious "right" has gone so far to the "right" that they are totally wrong! The religious "left" has gone so far to the "left" that there is nothing "left" at all. Both positions leave the people starving for the Word of God.

The next verse of our reading says: <sup>18</sup> Therefore I advise you to buy from me gold refined by fire so that you may be rich, and white robes to clothe yourself and to keep the shame of your nakedness from being seen, and salve to anoint your eyes so that you may see.

At Ray Of Hope, we know the "gold" that can stand the test of life is the Word of God, the Worship of the Community, and the Holy Communion of that "common-union" of Church community together in Christ. We know, this is the gold our people are looking for.

We also know the "salve" is the oil of healing, understanding, empathy, and love we receive through the powerful ministry of the Holy Spirit. We use oil with blessing and prayer to remind us the sweet healing power of Christ is always ready to anoint us. We know that all LGBTQSIANE2ss+ people are welcome to receive the white robes of salvation and are being dressed in those robes by the cruelty thrust upon us by the church and the state "in the Name" of Jesus, Tradition, and the Bible.

The world churches that have dug in with terrible dogmas and teachings not based on the fundamental languages of the Bible have and will continue to experience reproof from Christ. So many churches are choosing their denominational dogmas, teachings, and practices over the freedom of the salve, the gold, and the covering of Christ, which God is holding out to them.

We continue to stand alongside the institutional church and offer our assistance. We have even offered to help congregations like ours set up as independent churches to assist believers who want to reach out to those rejected by the churches.



There has been an almost endless list of reasons to exclude people from the Blessed Sacrament. Yet, together, during the worship service, we recite the very words of Jesus, the Words of Institution, "This is my body. This is my blood," and we rehear Christ present with us saying: "Take this, all of you and eat; Take this all of you and drink" of this gift.

After extensive consideration, I take these words, "Take this, all of you.." as a command to the Church to give and bring the Eucharistic Gift to everyone who will receive. This approach also requires us to educate people about this gift.
