+ The Candle Of Hope







First Reading: Wisdom is portrayed as the Divine in the feminine. She is "easily discerned," "found by those who seek her," and "hastens to make herself known.." Anyone who wants her "will have no difficulty" finding her; she waits in the morning to be let in. She promises "perfect understanding," if you seek her with vigilance, you "will soon be free from care" even. In fact, according to the Scriptures, she "goes about seeking those worthy of her, shows up "in their

WOW, what a deal! We are reminded of the letter to the Church of Laodicea, Revelation Chapter 3:20 "Listen! I am standing at the door, knocking; if you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in and eat with you, and you with me."

Here, we have two members of the Trinity just waiting for us to open the door of our person, set aside our desire to concentrate on ourselves, and let the Wisdom of God and the Son of the Most High in. God is ready and waiting for our invitation.

I find it very interesting that this first reading was selected to match the theme of the second reading and the Gospel. It indicates to me that the framers of the Lectionary knew very well that the misunderstanding around the concept of "The Rapture" is easily explained, and anyone who sincerely sought to see it would be guided to the understanding by God.

In my email to you, I wrote:

Is "The Rapture" in the Bible? Really? Isn't this some "fundie goofy invention" or something cultish?

Well, the reading that is the basis of this Doctrine is scheduled for tomorrow in the Lectionary. Many preachers will skip right over it because their denomination will not allow them to tell the people the truth. Tomorrow starts the season in the Lectionary for Eschatology. I often say it is the season when pastors, preachers, and priests say "I don't know. We don't know. or Just NO" more than any time of the lectionary year. Fortunately, I can tell the truth and not face discipline for teaching this Doctrine here at Ray Of Hope.

Come in tomorrow, and sharpen your tools to be able to explain and clear up the misinformation that is often circulated with this reading.

In John 14: 3, 18 Jesus said ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also. ¹⁸ "I will not leave you orphaned; I am coming to you."

So, we are to wait for the Bridegroom and keep our lamps lit, trimmed, and filled with oil. The images are pretty obvious: the wick is our life, trimming the wick is staying active in our Faith and the Church, hearing and learning the Word of God, confessing our sins, and continually practicing conversion. The oil is always the symbol and even the chosen instrument of the movement of the Holy Spirit. We were anointed with oil a couple of weeks ago, and we prayed for the Holy Spirit to give us a fresh and renewed start, healing, and so much more.

The event we are discussing is the Second Coming of Jesus. He has promised to come and take us to Himself on a day at a moment when we least expect Him.

WILL SOME BE LEFT BEHIND? Based upon this parable that explains the Doctrine of the Blessed Hope. Based upon the first few sentences of Paul's Second Letter to the Thessalonians:

The Man of Lawlessness

2 As to the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our being gathered together to him, we beg you, brothers and sisters, ² not to be quickly shaken in mind or alarmed, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as though from us, to the effect that the day of the Lord is already here. ³ Let no one deceive you in any way, for that day will not come unless the rebellion comes first and the lawless one^[2] is revealed, the one destined for destruction.^{[5] 4} He opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, declaring himself to be God. ⁵ Do you not remember that I told you these things when I was still with you? ⁶ And you know what is now restraining him, so that he may be revealed when his time comes. ⁷ For the mystery of lawlessness is

already at work, but only until the one who now restrains it is removed. ⁸ And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord Jesus^[C] will destroy^[d] with the breath of his mouth, annihilating him by the manifestation of his coming. ⁹ The coming of the lawless one is apparent in the working of Satan, who uses all power, signs, lying wonders, ¹⁰ and every kind of wicked deception for those who are perishing because they refused to love the truth and so be saved. ¹¹ For this reason God sends them a powerful delusion, leading them to believe what is false, ¹² so that all who have not believed the truth but took pleasure in unrighteousness will be condemned.

Finally, based upon the fact that after the seven letters to the seven churches in the Book of Revelation, the letters then turned out to be an outline of the record of the church up to today, the following verse is COME UP HERE, AND I WILL SHOW YOU THE THINGS THAT WILL SHORTLY TAKE PLACE AFTER THIS.



WHO SHOULD RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION, THE EUCHARIST, AT RAY OF HOPE CHURCH?

Everyone may receive Holy Communion, also known as The Eucharist, The Lord's Table, or The Blessed Sacrament at Ray Of Hope Church Of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Inc.

You are not required to be a member of this Church or any other church to receive Holy Communion at / or with Ray Of Hope Church.

This Holy Communion is the Table of Jesus Christ, who is present among us. Jesus invites you to receive Him in this Eucharistic banquet. If this is your first time receiving The Blessed Sacrament, let us know before you receive it, or right after so we might pray a special prayer of thanksgiving with you.

Unfortunately, through the centuries, many institutional churches have established rules, teachings, and practices that exclude people from Holy Communion. There has been an almost endless list of reasons to exclude people from the Blessed Sacrament. Yet, together, during the worship service, we recite the very words of Jesus, the Words of Institution, "This is my body. This is my blood," and we rehear Christ present with us 11-12-23 Veterans Day Weekend Sunday, Year A Page 39 of 42 saying: "Take this, all of you and eat; Take this all of you and drink" of this gift.

After extensive consideration, I take these words, "Take this, all of you.." as a command to the Church to give and bring the Eucharistic Gift to everyone who will receive. This approach also requires us to educate people about this gift. I have said it is **uniquely and deliberately the work of Christ in His Church** to offer the necessary education, guidance, and practices that help people live a life centered and purposed on finding and sharing the Will of God. The Lord's Table is central to that life.

The Eucharist belongs to the Church. The Blessed Sacrament is Christ in, through, with us, and made known in breaking the Bread of Life and drinking the Cup of Salvation. We are to take this gift to the whole World.

We begin by inviting those on the fringe of Society, those pushed aside, poor, not accepted, sick, and who need God's help in extraordinary ways.

We welcome and bring the Eucharist to everyone told they cannot receive it by other Denominations. In conclusion, to everyone told "no, you cannot" go to Communion in any other church; hear us, "yes, you can" at Ray Of Hope. All are welcome. Or, as we like to say as one of our mottos when we quote Fr. Bartholomew J. O'Brien, "You are as welcome here as Christ Himself."
