Our St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi bell at Ray Of Hope Church, 380 W. 1st St. in Elmira, NY, is a gift from Michael Quinnell of Syracuse, NY, given in September 2005. The bell rings out 39 joyful rings, in contrast to tolling the bell in single rings. The 39 joyful rings honor the 39 lashes Jesus endured, and we now celebrate victory and gratitude for our Salvation. "The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes, we are healed." (Isaiah 53:5) We ring the bell before worship and Bible Enrichment sessions. Listen carefully and see if you can hear all 39 rings.



Leader -3: Please be seated. Today, we begin the season of Advent, the beginning of a new year in the Church. We start over in the cycle of Sunday Scripture readings to listen anew to the living Word of God. This season is a time of renewal, fresh beginnings, of ages old, present, and future.

ALL: This is also a season of longing, filled with expectation, excited by hope, sprinkled with potential and promise.

Leader -2: The evergreen on the wreath reminds us of the eternal promises of God's sustaining grace. God is faithful and will fulfill every promise made in Scripture. The four candles remind us of our place in time as we move forward in God's plan. Each candle has a name and a theme.

The first candle is purple and named for Hope. On the first candle, we also have the Red AIDS Ribbon for World AIDS Day. We observe this memorial most Sundays of the year as we light our Candle of Hope, which is here today because of World AIDS Day.

The second candle is also purple and named for Peace. During the second week, we will pray for world peace.

The third candle is rose color and is for Joy, and it is when we shall celebrate Pride in the Winter, Gaudete Sunday.

The fourth candle is purple and named for Love. On the 4th Sunday, we will celebrate Holy Mother Mary and all Holy Women of Faith for a Mother's and Women's Day in the Winter.



Leader - 4: Please take a moment to look at the AIDS NAMES Memorial

display board on the wall. Members of our Congregation made this posting board between 1983 and 1986 to honor the memory of friends and lovers who died of HIV and AIDS. It is interesting to look closely at the pieces of paper because many of the names are written in pencil. The names of some of the Ray Of Hope Church Founders are on this board and are the original posting papers. Glenn Rathbun and Wayne Harris lovingly restored the board for rededication and are bringing it back into use today. Thank you. Starting today, anyone may add the names of their loved ones too.

Leader -1: At this time, we will bless our Advent Wreath or Advent Yule Log and rededicate the Memorial board with Holy Water. Please pick up the container with the water or touch it and pray silently as I pray out loud. (please wait) Dear God, we dedicate this water to you and ask you to make it Holy, setting it apart as an instrument of your blessings. We ask this in the name of Jesus. **ALL: Amen.**

Pastor: We pray aloud together now:

ALL: O Loving and Gracious God, we ask your Holy Spirit to bless these Advent decorations, rededicate this Memorial board, bless this holy season, and bless us as we begin anew our journey with You. We dedicate ourselves and these next four weeks of Advent to You. We ask you to speak to us, guide us, and impassion our hearts with your Divine Love. We ask this in the Name of (*+*) God, the Christ, and the Holy Spirit. Amen.

It just happens that the first candle on the Advent Wreath is named Hope as well. So, as we sing O Come, O Come Emmanuel, in just a moment, keep in mind all those who have gone before us, especially those who died of AIDS, and everyone who has entered the divine protection of Christ, who is Lord of the living and the Dead (Romans 14:9). When Emmanuel comes to take us home, they will come with Him. Together we sing in thanksgiving and waiting the first two verses of O Come, O Come

Emmanuel.

THE TREASURER'S REPORT FOR OCTOBER, 2024, given by Ed Askins, Treasurer, at the November 21, 2024 of the Church Council.

General Fund opening balance at the beginning of October was \$1,016.27. Donations to the General Fund for the month were \$1,963.03 which includes the undeposited funds off \$122.66 from last month. Pastoral compensation of \$495.00 per week for 5 week was paid equaling \$2,475.00, Verizon \$62.39 and Paypal charges of \$40.03 came out of this account. After these were paid the ending balance of this account at the end of the month was \$401.88.

Building Fund opening balance was \$1,242.41. Donations to the Building Fund were as follows: Brother Shawn Benedict \$640.00, Kaiden Benedict \$400.00 and transferred in \$309.95 from the Building Improvement fund. Regular bills that came out of the fund this month was the Credit Card bill with Key Bank of \$61.41, electric \$633.92, gas bill \$253.00, Isaac's Heating and Air Conditioning \$309.95 for boiler repair and I transferred \$200.00 into savings to save for the liability insurance bill that will be due the beginning of December. Ending balance of this fund was \$1,134.08.

Building Improvement Fund opening balance on this account was \$4,888.99. Donations to this account for this month were as follows: Undeposited funds from September from Ian and Christina \$627.34, Anonymous donation of \$500.00, a second Anonymous donation of \$200.00, Veronica and Tami \$150.00, Denise Robinson \$100.00, Diane Housely \$50.00 and Tejuana McMillian \$25.00. I transferred to the Building Fund \$309.95 to cover the Isaac's invoice listed above. The ending balance on this account is \$6,231.38.

Savings (Council) Account opening balance \$243.65. I transferred in \$200.00 from the building to cover the upcoming liability insurance payment, so the ending balance in this account is \$443.65. There was a gifts in kind donation of \$40.00 by Ed Askins to cover the cost of the gate repair done by Travis Askins.

There were no undeposited funds for the month of October.




