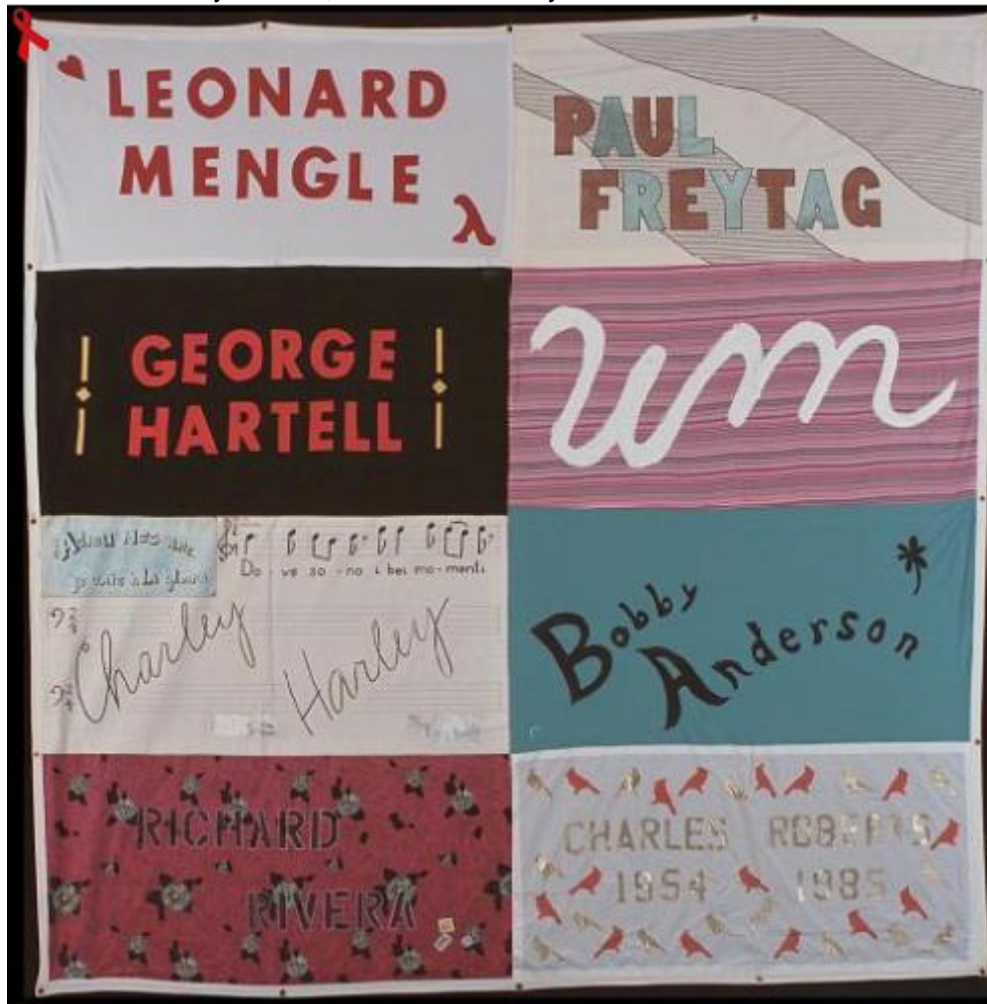
+ The Candle Of Hope

Leader - 2: Today, we light our Candle Of Hope to celebrate our Faith and trust in the promised "Blessed Hope," also known as "The Rapture," the return of Christ who will transform the living faithful and raise all to new life. Those viewing at home may light a special candle and bring it to your table. Now, everyone, please join me and recite these words of Jesus to celebrate the Truth they promise us. Jesus said: (John 5:25 and Titus 2:13)

ALL: "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25, 26)

Leader -2: In 1983, Ray Of Hope Church was started in part to form a unique ministry to persons affected by and infected with HIV and AIDS and to extend a radical welcome to all people to worship with us. Our witness to God's unconditional love for everyone is as relevant today as in 1983. Here we are forty-one years later, and still, some churches, religions, and, yes, even some countries continue rejecting the sick, lonely, and dying people with HIV and AIDS who deserve comfort and spiritual guidance.

Therefore, at Ray Of Hope Church Of Our Lord Jesus Christ, we continue to read aloud over **110,000** names sewn into the AIDS Memorial Quilt to keep HIV/AIDS in the conscious prayers of people. Scroll the page to see the panels on block 142.



Our first reading is in the Book of Genesis chapter 15, verses 1-12, 17 and 18. You will find this on page 12 in the front of the NRSV Bible. I will be reading from The Inclusive Bible. Here begins the reading:

15 :¹ After these events, the word of YHWH came to Abram in a vision:

"Fear not, Abram! I am your shield;
I will make your reward very great."

² Abram said, "But my Sovereign, My God, what good are these blessings to me, so long as Sarai and I will die in disgrace? My only heir is a foreigner who lives in my household, Eliezer of Damascus."³ Since you have given me no offspring," Abram continued, "an attendant in my house will be my heir."⁴ Then the word of YHWH

came to Abram and said, "This person will not be your heir. Your heir will be of your own flesh and blood."⁵ Then God took Abram outside and said, "Look up at the sky and count the stars, if you can! As many as that, you will have for descendants."⁶ Abram believed YHWH, and God accounted it to Abram as righteousness.⁷ YHWH then said to Abram, "I am YHWH who brought you from Ur of the Chaldeans to give you this land as a possession."⁸ Abram asked, "Sovereign God, how am I to know that I will possess it?"⁹ God answered Abram, "Bring me a heifer, a goat, and a ram, each three years old, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon."¹⁰ Abram brought all of these, cut them in half, and placed each half opposite the other—except the birds, which he did not cut up.¹¹ Birds of prey swooped down on the carcasses, but Abram drove them away.¹² As the sun was about to set, a trance fell over Abram, and a deep, terrifying darkness enveloped him.¹³ Then YHWH said to Abram, "Know this: your descendants will be aliens in a land that is not their own; they will be enslaved in that place and oppressed for 400 years.¹⁴ But I will punish the nation that enslaves you, and in time you will leave that place with great possessions.¹⁵ As for you, you will go to your ancestors peacefully, and be buried in your old age. .."

¹⁷ When the sun had set and it was dark, a smoking brazier and a flaming torch appeared, which passed between the halves of the sacrifices.¹⁸ On that day YHWH made this covenant with Abram: "To your descendants I give this land, from the River of Egypt to the Great River, the Euphrates:.."

Our second reading is found in the Book of Philippians, chapter 3, verses 17 through Chapter 4, verse 1. You will find this on page 198 in the back, the second testament of the NRSV Bible. I will be reading from the Inclusive Bible. Here begins the reading:

Join in following my example, my sisters and brothers. Take as your guide those who follow the example that we set.¹⁸ Unfortunately, many go about in a way which shows them to be enemies of the cross of Christ. I have often said this to you before; this time I say it with tears:¹⁹ their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and their glory is in their shame. I'm talking about those whose minds are set on the things of this world.²⁰ But we have our citizenship in heaven; it's from there that we eagerly await the coming of our Savior Jesus Christ,²¹ who will give a new form to this lowly body of ours and remake it according to the pattern of the glorified body, by Christ's power to bring everything under subjection.^{4:1} For these reasons, my sisters and brothers—you whom I so love and long for, you who are my joy and my crown—continue, my dear ones, to stand firm in Christ Jesus.

Qualities of St. Patrick 385 - 461 AD

Prayerful man who loved the Holy Spirit: "And again I saw Him praying in me, and I seemed to be within my body, and I heard Him above me, that is, over my inward self, and there He prayed with great emotion. And all the time I was astonished, and wondered, and thought with myself who it could be that prayed in me. But at the end of the prayer He spoke, saying that He was the Spirit; and so I woke up, and remembered the Apostle saying: The Spirit helps the infirmities of our prayer."

Converted sinner, man of God: "I am Patrick, a sinner, most unlearned, the least of all the faithful, and utterly despised by many ... But the Lord opened my unbelieving heart that I might at last remember my sins and be converted with all my heart to the Lord my God, who had regard for my abjection, and mercy on my youth and ignorance, and watched over me before I knew Him... comforted me as would a father his son. So I cannot be silent – nor should I be – about the great benefits and the great grace which the Lord has deigned to bestow upon me in the land of my captivity." He was deeply grateful for the work of grace within him.

Patrick loved the Bible: In his preaching Patrick reverently sprinkled his thoughts with quotations from Holy Scripture. "This reverence for the Bible marked the Irish church in the following centuries, and resulted in important early Irish commentaries, as well as lovely manuscript copies of the Gospel, like the Book of Kells."

Inspirational Pastor: "For I am much God's debtor, who gave me such grace that many people were reborn in God through me and afterwards confirmed, and that clerics were ordained for them everywhere, for a people just coming to the faith, whom the Lord took from the utmost parts of the earth."

Patrick was resolved to remain with the Irish until his death.

Subject: New area of concern that has surfaced regarding website

Dear Members and Friends, to keep you informed, we wanted to share with you that we have been notified by an organization called PicRights International Inc. that we alleged used images that were copyrighted on our website in 2021. This is a new area of concerns that we are facing as Pic Rights operates on behalf of the Associated Press and EPA photographers. We are being told that this is a copyright violation and were initially fined a total of \$1,875 for 5 images. The images used were all linked to an article that was posted for educational and religious education purposes. They in essence were part of the article.

Although we believe all rules of the Fair Use Act were applied and materials well sourced on our website, I was told that those rules of engagement do not apply to the use of these images on our website. Br. Benedict has worked tirelessly and continues to do so to ensure everything we do is in compliance and we thank him for all the hours he has donated to this.

The council is 100% committed to getting clarification on what the rules of engagement are and putting into place compliance with those rules if indeed they are not what we believe to be the case so this is not a recurring issue. We have spoken with a friend of the church who provided us with some attorneys that specialize in Intellectual property and copyright laws. We are moving forward with contacting an attorney to represent us.

We were able to negotiate an offer with PicRights due to our status as a Not for Profit Religious Corporation as well as the impact such a stiff fee would have on our church finances. The reduced fee is a 60% reduction to \$750. We were given a due date of February 14, 2025 to take advantage of the negotiated rate. We will be speaking with an attorney prior to that time to see if this is the best course of action for us at this time and how to proceed in the future.

I am bringing this to the attention of all our members and friends to first make you aware of the concern. Secondly, if you would like to assist with website maintenance expenses, please contact our treasurer Ed Askins. Any amount of donation would be beneficial. Also, if you know anyone who has copyright law experience that could help us moving forward, please let any council member know.

We will keep you informed of any updated developments.

As always, we thank you for your generosity and support as we endeavor to do God's work together and give God glory and praise.
