The Angel of The Lord appears in Scripture, God carries out an act of Salvation. Here in Exodus, God is saving the people of Israel out of Egypt and bringing them back to the Mountain of God. See the summary in your Scofield Notes at Judges 2:1, page 341 in Scofield III.

The "flame of fire out of a bush; he looked, and the bush was blazing, yet it was not consumed," seems to indicate the Holy Spirit, in my opinion. Fire is often associated with the Holy Spirit, even on the Day of Pentecost, when flames of fire appear over the head of each person in the room. See Acts 2:3; see also 9c in the summary on the Holy Spirit in the New Testament, page 1495 in Scofield III.

God called him out of the bush, "Moses, Moses!"

I see the entire Holy Trinity in this epiphany of "the burning bush," as it is commonly called.

One session in our series on Angels will focus on "The Angel of The Lord," the Christ before taking on human flesh in Bethlehem.

Angels guard and protect us. The Angel of The Lord, the Christ of God, guards and protects. Jesus said each person is given their guardian angel in Mathew 18:10 "Take care that you do not despise one of these little ones, for I tell you, in heaven their angels continually see the face of my Father in heaven." (NRSVUE) The angel given to each is not taken away when one becomes an adult. (Romans 11:29 "29 for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.") I have guardian angel stories from my own life, do you?

Second Reading: Hebrews 1 2b-3a "heir of all things, through whom he also created the worlds. ³ He is the reflection of God's glory and the exact imprint of God's very being, and he sustains [b] all things by his powerful word." This first chapter of the Book of Hebrews clearly states the highest place in Creation, the Christ of God, Jesus born in the flesh, has forever, even above prophets and angels. The people understood prophets, The Angel of The Lord, and other angels, seraphim and cherubim. Through the ministry of the Apostles, we learn that Christ has risen above them and shares in the Divine Nature of being God. For our purposes today, the Book of Hebrews ascribes to the Doctrine that Angels are real.

Matthew 25:31 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory."

Notice there is no doubt in the words of Jesus that He will be accompanied by "all the angels." He states the reality of angels as a fact of Creation.

The angels seem to be pretty important. Therefore, as your Pastor, I must direct you to the Word of God, the Bible, where we will "recall, reflect, and rejoice" (our prayer before the Service of the Word) to learn the Doctrine of the Angels.

In (Rev 8:3-5), Christ is evidently meant.

Sometimes, angel is used of the spirit of man. (Mat 18:10); (Act 12:15). Though angels are spirits; (Psa 104:4); (Heb 1:14); power is given them to become visible in the semblance of human form. (Gen 19:1).

Compare (Gen 19:5); (Exo 3:2); (Num 22:22-31); (Jdg 2:1); (Jdg 6:11); (Jdg 6:22); (Jdg 13:3); (Jdg 13:6); (1Ch 21:16); (1Ch 21:20); (Mat 1:20); (Luk 1:26); (Joh 20:12); (Act 7:30); (Act 12:7); (Act 12:8); etc.).

The word is always used in the masculine gender, though sex, in the human sense, is never ascribed to angels. (Mat 22:30); (Mar 12:25).

They are exceedingly numerous. (Mat 26:53); (Heb 12:22); (Rev 5:11); (Psa 68:17).

Their power is inconceivable. (2Ki 19:35).

Their place is about the throne of God. (Rev 5:11); (Rev 7:11).

Their relation to the believer is that of "ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation", and this ministry has reference largely to the physical safety and well-being of believers. (1Ki 19:5); (Psa 34:7); (Psa 91:11); (Dan 6:22); (Mat 2:13); (Mat 2:19); (Mat 4:11); (Luk 22:43); (Act 5:19); (Act 12:7-10).

From (Heb 1:14); (Mat 18:10); (Psa 91:11), it would seem that this care for the heirs of salvation begins in infancy and continues through life.

The angels observe us; (1Co 4:9); (Eph 3:10); (Ecc 5:6); a fact which should influence conduct.

They receive departing saints. (Luk 16:22).

Man is made "a little lower than the angels," and in incarnation, Christ took "for a little "time" this lower place (Psa_8:4); (Psa_8:5); (Heb_2:6); (Heb_2:9) that He might lift the believer into His own sphere above angels. (Heb_2:9); (Heb_2:10).

The angels are to accompany Christ in His second advent. (Mat 25:31).

To them will be committed the preparation of the judgment of the nations. (Mat 13:30); (Mat 13:39); (Mat 13:41); (Mat 13:42).

(See Scofield) - (Mat 25:32).

The kingdom-age is not to be subject to angels, but to Christ and those for whom He was made a little lower than the angels. (Heb 2:5).

An archangel, Michael, is mentioned as having a particular relation to Israel and to the resurrections. (<u>Dan_10:13</u>); (<u>Dan_10:21</u>); (<u>Dan_12:1</u>); (<u>Dan_12:2</u>); (<u>Jud_1:9</u>); (<u>Jud_1:9</u>);

There has been an almost endless list of reasons to exclude people from the Blessed Sacrament. Yet, together, during the worship service, we recite the very words of Jesus, the Words of Institution, "This is my body. This is my blood," and we rehear Christ present with us saying: "Take this, all of you and eat; Take this all of you and drink" of this gift.

After extensive consideration, I take these words, "Take this, all of you.." as a command to the Church to give and bring the Eucharistic Gift to everyone who will receive. This approach also requires us to educate people about this gift. I have said it is uniquely and deliberately the work of Christ in His Church to offer the necessary education, guidance, and practices that help people live a life centered and purposed on finding and sharing the Will of God. The Lord's Table is central to that life.

The Eucharist belongs to the Church. The Blessed Sacrament is Christ in, through, with us, and made known in breaking the Bread of Life and drinking the Cup of Salvation. We are to take this gift to the whole World.

We begin by inviting those on the fringe of Society, those pushed aside, poor, not accepted, sick, and who need God's help in extraordinary ways.

We welcome and bring the Eucharist to everyone told they cannot receive it by other Denominations. In conclusion, to everyone told "no, you cannot" go to Communion in any other church; hear us, "yes, you can" at Ray Of Hope. All are welcome. Or, as we like to say as one of our mottos when we quote Fr. Bartholomew J. O'Brien, "You are as welcome here as Christ Himself."
