




³ Don't you know that when we were baptized into Christ Jesus, we were baptized into Christ's death? 4 We've been buried with Jesus through baptism, and we joined with Jesus in death, so that as Christ was raised from the dead by God's glory, we too might live a new life. ⁵ For if we have been united with Christ in the likeness of Christ's death, we will also be united with Christ in the likeness of Christ's resurrection. ⁶ We must realize that our former selves have been crucified with Christ to make the body of sin and failure completely powerless, to free us from slavery to sin: 7 for when people die, they have finished with sin. 8 But we believe that, having died with Christ, we will also live with Christ—9 knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, will never die again: death is now powerless over our Savior. 10 When Christ died, Christ died to sin, once for all, so that the life Christ lives is now life in God. ¹¹ In this way, you too must consider yourselves to be dead to sin—but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

In John 4:10, Jesus said to the woman at the well of Jacob: "If you knew the gift of God, and who it was who says to you, 'Give Me a drink,' you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water.'...

B Page 18 of 42 In John 4:13-14, Jesus continues by saying, "Whoever drinks of the natural water of the well will thirst again, but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give will never thirst. Again, in John Chapter 7, verses 37 – 39, we hear the voice of Jesus saying: "If anyone thirsts, let them come to Me and drink. Those who believe in Me, as Scripture has said, out of their heart will flow rivers of living water." John, the Beloved Disciple, then writes Jesus was speaking "concerning the Holy Spirit, whom those believing in Jesus would receive: for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified."

+ Statement of Faith, Renewal of Baptismal Promises

Leader-1: The first part of our service is hearing the Word of God and responding with songs, hymns, and spiritual songs. Now, we begin the second part of our service with water. We have heard the Revelation of Christ, the Only Begotten Son of God; now we respond with the renewal of our commitment in the waters of Baptism. ** If you are at home, you may bring a small bowl of water to the table at this time and a branch if you want to sprinkle it, or you may touch it when it is time.

Pastor Benedict: There are three modes of Baptism. "Since early in the Church's history, three different modes of baptism have been used: aspersion (sprinkling); affusion (pouring); and immersion (dipping)." (Source: page 1507 Scofield, III NKJV at Acts 8:12 summary. © Oxford University Press 2002) Katrina chose affusion - pouring. Katrina was given several spoken formulas for the action of baptism, and she chose "In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."



SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE A GIFT DONATION. FROM VERONICA FLOYD, CLERK

Dear Friends and Members,

On a recent Monday afternoon the Carbon Monoxide Alarms rang on the first floor of the church and monastery. It turns out the broken bolt and old seal (apparently one was not replaced in the last kit replacement) on the existing boiler were allowing Carbon Monoxide to leak out of the boiler and upstairs through the floor and walls. The boiler is shut off and the system is taken off line because it is leaking Carbon Monoxide. The heat to the entire building is off until the Heat Exchanger Kit is installed.

We have received an estimate from Isaac Heating & Air Conditioning of \$3,230.79 to cover the parts and time it takes two technicians to do the exchange which is approximately 6 hours. This is the initial estimate for phase 1 of repairs needed. The second estimate to add a larger pump to solve the problem of getting the heat upstairs and to the back corners of the building has been received in the amount of \$1,712.83. Therefore the total amount to get the boiler functional and the pump installed is \$4,943.62.

The Council met on Thursday, September 26th and approved the plans to get this urgent emergency repair completed. We are so thankful for all donations received thus far for this repair. There is still a need for donations to help with this as we will need to quickly replenish the funds that will be required from the Building Improvement Fund.

As you may know, we have been saving to get the external building painted and eliminate any potential fines for not being up to code. This current emergency repair will deplete that savings.

So again, we thank all of you for your past generosity and for any financial assistance you can give at this time towards the boiler repair and external painting of the building.

The goal is to get the parts ordered and repair scheduled before we need the boiler to be operational with the declining temperatures as well as the building painted.

Thank you in advance for your support. Any amount given will be of great support.

The Treasurer's Report for the month of August 2024; presented September 26, 2024.

General Fund opening balance at the beginning of the month was \$1,043.91. Donations to the General Fund for the month were \$1,368.50. There were 2 people who deposited their August donations in July, so this figure is lower than normal by about \$800.00 Pastoral compensation of \$495.00 per week was paid, Verizon \$62.13, a reimbursement to me for the wine and grape juice kits of \$91.44 and Paypal charge comes out of this account. After these were paid the ending balance of this account at the end of the month was \$265.34.

Building Fund opening balance was \$1,357.42. Donations to the Building Fund were as follows: Brother Shawn Benedict \$640.00, Kaiden Benedict \$400.00. I transferred back in from Savings \$662.33 also. Regular bills that came out of the fund this month was the Credit Card bill with Key Bank of \$61.42, electric \$233.92 (which has increased \$100 per month), gas bill \$253.00, water bill \$82.79, Fire Inspection fee of \$60.00, Isaac's Plumbing and Heating \$364.95 and I paid the Liability Insurance bill of \$662.33. Ending balance of this fund was \$1,341.34.

Building Improvement Fund opening balance on this account was \$2,452.49. We had no activity on this account during August. Ian & Christina's donation was done on Paypal September 1st, so that will be on next month's report. So the ending balance on this account is \$2,452.29.

Savings (Council) Account opening balance \$705.33. I transferred \$662.33 to the building fund to cover the liability insurance payment, so the ending balance in this account is \$43.65.

These balances do equal the ending bank balances.

This report was presented at the September 26, 2024 Council Meeting by Mr. Edward Askins, Council Treasurer.
