On Sunday, January 8, 2023 we were celebrating the Feast of the Epiphany. In fact, we made this our theme: We need an epiphany. We actually prayed in the Prayers of the People: "Oh God, thank you for guiding Ray Of Hope through 2022. We ask for your blessing in this new year of 2023. Give us a new epiphany and vision for this new year. In thanksgiving, we pray to the Lord."

We were not prepared for what God had in store for us during the worship event. During our worship service, we had a Eucharistic Miracle as a cross appeared on the host, the wafer, that was about to be received by Ian from Christina. The Eucharistic Miracle was a sign of strength for Ian and Christina and that God is with them and hearing their prayers during this time of transition and change for Ian. This event also has meaning for all of us individually and as Ray Of Hope Church.

I have looked at the pictures I took after worship a few times and thought I was seeing the Tau Cross, which looks like the Latin letter T. This cross is also known as the Saint Anthony of Egypt Cross. Tertullian (c. 155- c. 240) wrote this was often the kind of cross used for executions, the T. St. Francis of Assisi (1181 – 1226) used the Tau cross as his signature and personal seal. The Tau cross was also popular in the Church at the time of the life of Francis. There also is an interesting connection for us as our Congregation is close to the ministry of Francis, who taught the Church to welcome and embrace all people.

We received a Eucharistic Miracle as Christina was about to give her husband, Ian Holy Communion when a cross appeared on the Host wafer in her hand. We stopped to examine and inspect it and all agreed that it is there. This inspired us to take out the storage showcases of two previous Eucharistic Miracles that happened at Ray Of Hope and to show those. Indeed, this was a very important day for the LGBTQSIA2ss+ Community as God personally gave us a visual sign of Real Presence in Holy Communion. We experienced a real epiphany today.
