Presbuteros, episkopos designate the same office. Bishop, overseer. Presbuteros refers to the person, episkopos refers to the office. (Scofield, pg. 1473)

The functions of the Elder, Bishop include:

To rule (1 Tim. 3:4-5; 5:17)

To teach (1 Tim 5:17)

To guard the body of revealed truth from perversion and error (Ti. 1:9)

Oversee the church as a shepherd his flock (Jn. 21:16; Acts 20:28; Heb. 13:17; 1 Pet. 5:2)

The Holy Spirit places elders in the church (Acts 20:28)

The Christian Testament lays great emphasis on their due appointment. (Acts 14:23; Ti. 1:5)

Qualifications for a Bishop and Deacons 1 Tim. 3

The Christian Testament has many verses showing it is the duty of Christians to support the ministry. Matt. 10:10; Luke 10:7; 1 Cor. 9:4-14; 1 Tim. 5;17-18
